It started out with a weather report that said we could be looking at 6-foot seas. A quick call to Captain Jim confirmed that we could be looking at 6-inch seas. The dive was a go.

Don and Lori Zoecklein along with daughter Jennifer joined Janet Fisher, Mike Cruse, "Sam" Juleff and new member Alex Nichol for an exciting cruise the lasted a little more than 3 hours. We had the boat to ourselves. Captain John Allen and dive master John 2 didn't know what to think.
