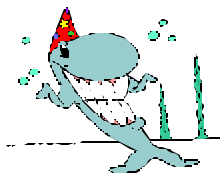

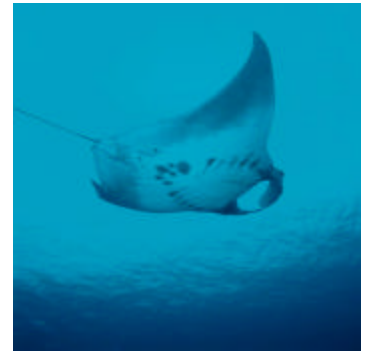
General Meetings:
