~~*We don't dive with just any buddy*~~

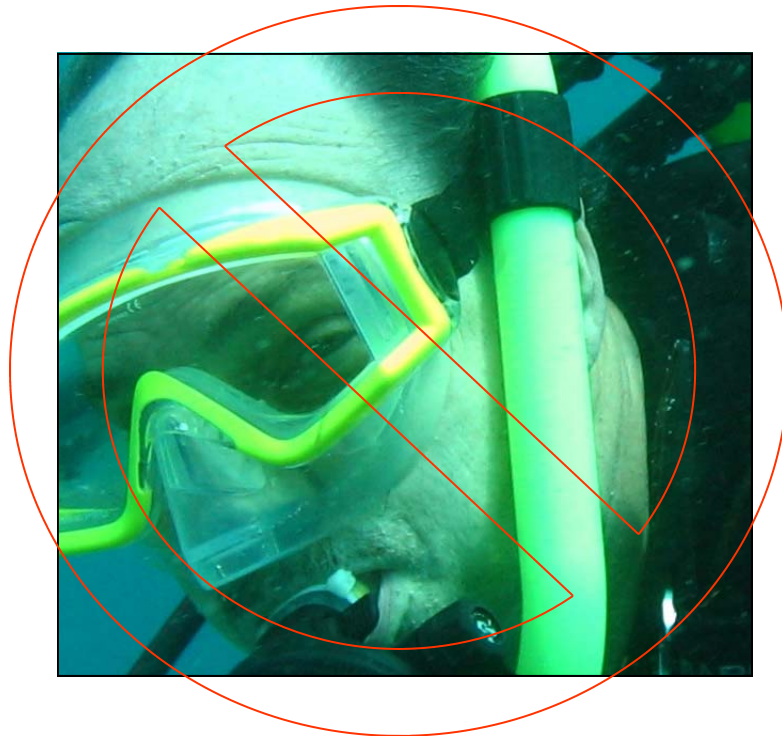
Central Florida Pleasure Divers has decided it's time to change the club motto from ~~*We don't dive with just any buddy*~~ to ??????

Boat leaves at 8:30. Be there early if renting equipment and call ahead.

If you are new to Sea Dog, bring a log book or "Advanced Certificate" verification.
