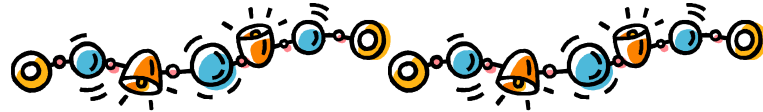




# HAPPY HOLIDAYS 2010
